- \* Entries will be judged based on **theme adherence, originality, and lighting.**
- \* The parade route will run down 6th St. from Dogwood, to Forest Avenue.
- \* **Check-in** will be located at 6th and Dogwood, starting at **3:30 p.m.**
- \* **Judging** will take place at **4 p.m.** Entries must be in place, fully decorated with lights, and with all participants present at that time.
- \* **The parade will begin promptly at 5 p.m.**

## PARADE RULES:

FOR THE SAFETY OF THOSE WATCHING AND PARTICIPATING IN THE PARADE, PLEASE FOLLOW THE BELOW RULES:

- 1) All entries must be decorated and have lights to participate. Also, **NO Santa Clauses.** He will make an appearance at the end of the parade.
- 2) Do not allow more than a 30-foot gap between you and the participant ahead of you during the parade.
- 3) Participants that have floats or large entries must have people walking on each corner of the entry during the length of the parade. This is to help control children who may run up to the float/entry.
- 4) Mounted entries must have walkers next to them. This is for the safety of the horse, rider, and those watching the parade.
- 5) Pooper Scoopers are required for all Mounted/Animal Entries. Use along parade route and staging area.

## RULES FOR TOSSING CANDY:

- 1) Candy can only be tossed by individuals 12 years of age or older.
- 2) Candy must be tossed - not dropped - away from the vehicle or entry.
- 3) Candy cannot be tossed from large vehicles (e.g., semi-trucks or trucks pulling trailers.) Instead, if you'd like to distribute candy, you must have walkers on either side of your vehicle tossing or handing out candy.
